FOGLIE SIDEBOARD

The horizontal stratification of this solid-wood sideboard is more than just an aesthetic addition to a functional object. The slender louvres are also used as 'handles' to open and close the drawers. Foglie features mortise and tenon joints. Drawers are available in different 'heights'. Suitable as a freestanding object or as a piece of furniture for use against a wall.

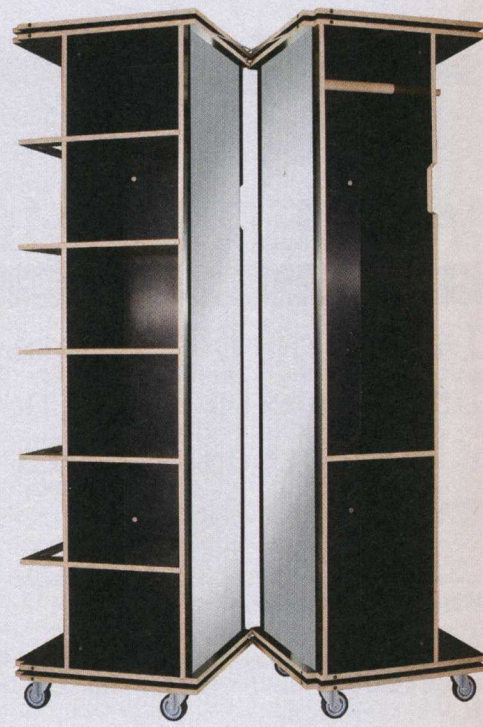

TURNABLE BY SEBASTIAN DÄSCHLE

A revolving wardrobe provides storage for clothes, a mirror for reflection and casters for mobility. What designer Sebastian Däschle calls 'an endless hinge' allows the wardrobe to be opened from all sides. The material is quality plywood. Turntable measures 185 x 110 x 55 cm.
